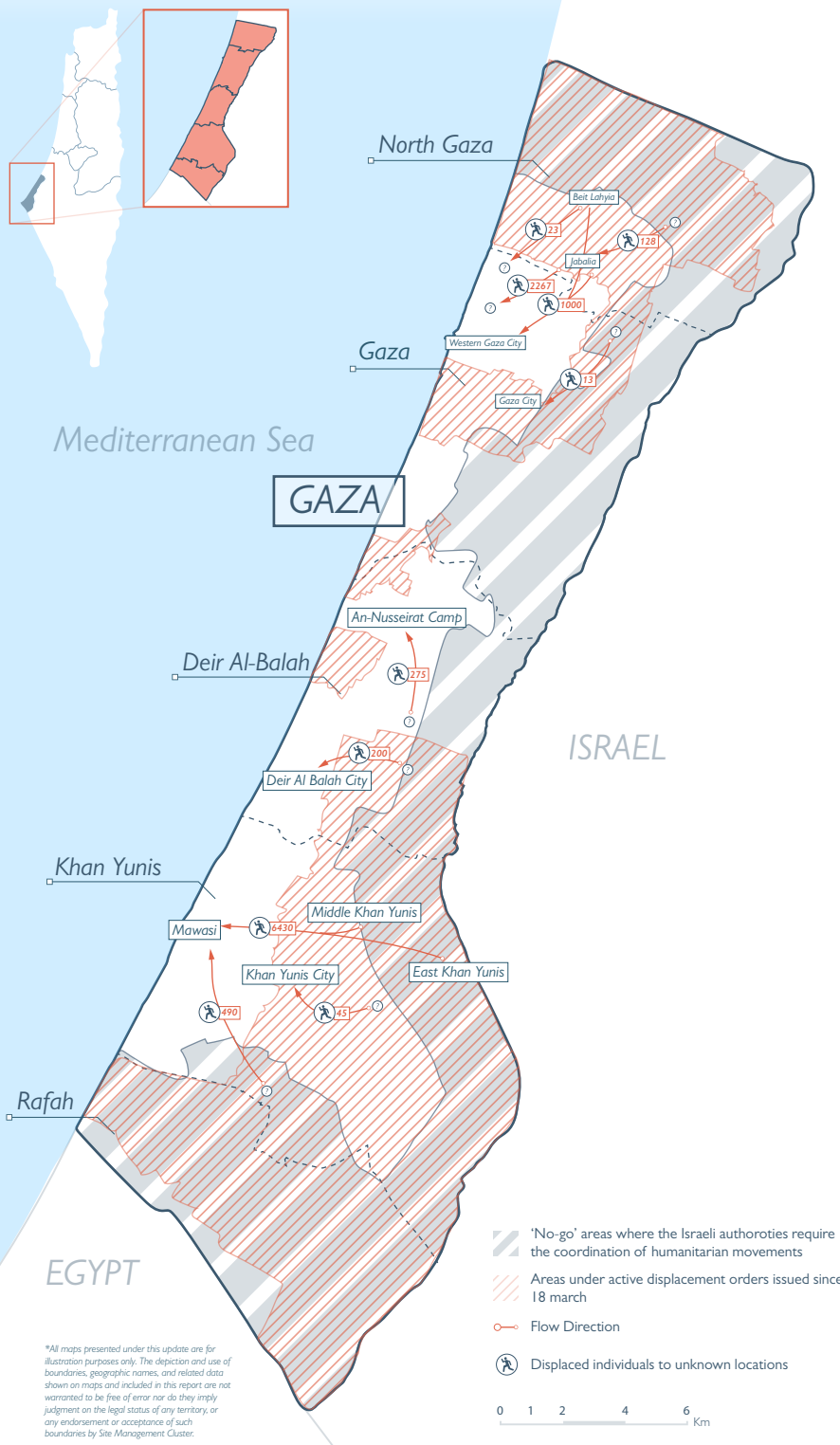


Population Movement Monitoring Ad-Hoc Report

Since 15 May 2025, displacement has rapidly increased following new displacement orders, as well as significant scale up in military activity across many parts of the Gaza Strip.

This update outlines the scale, patterns, and impact of displacement in Gaza, offering insights into the ongoing humanitarian situation. Data was collected from eyewitness accounts, social media posts, and available datasets from Site Management Cluster (SMC) partners on the ground. The information was cross-referenced and analyzed to establish displacement patterns in the Gaza Strip.

Between 21 May 13:00pm –22 May 13:00 pm 2025, an estimated 10,871 individuals were displaced, based on reported movements, including those following direct targeting of displacement sites during that time. Between 15th of May and 22nd of May, 74,783 people were displaced in the southern 3 governorates, and 97,594 people were displaced in the northern 2 governorates.
