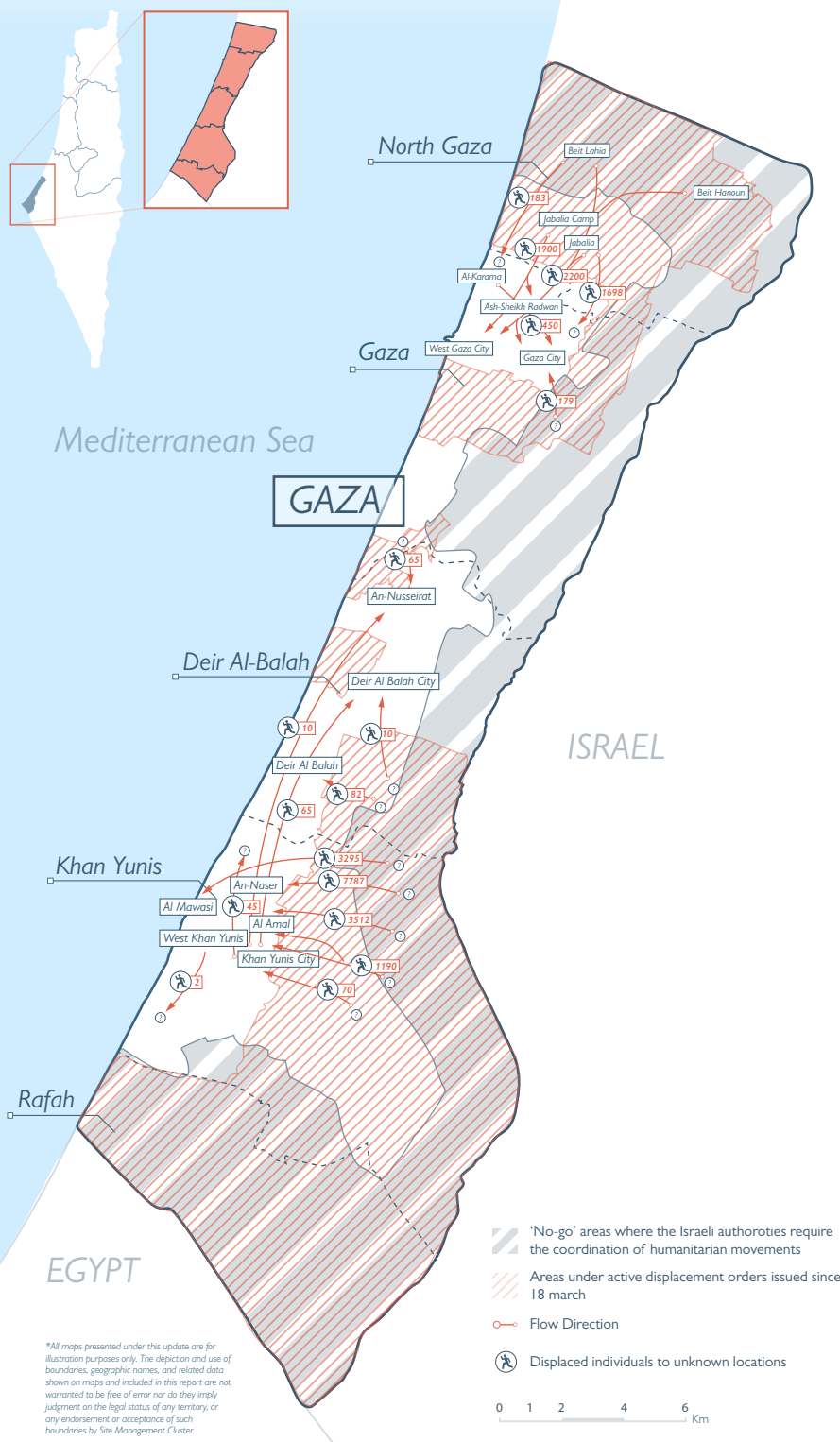


Population Movement Monitoring Flash-Update

The humanitarian situation in Gaza continues to deteriorate as displacement rose since the events of March 18, 2025. The escalation, combined with displacement orders have forced residents to flee their homes, seeking refuge in overcrowded displacement sites.

This update outlines the scale, patterns, and impact of displacement in Gaza, offering insights into the ongoing humanitarian situation. Data was collected from eyewitness accounts, social media posts, and available datasets from Site Management Cluster (SMC) partners on the ground. The information was cross-referenced and analyzed to establish displacement patterns and the impact on local infrastructure.

According to OCHA, 80% of Gaza is currently either within the "no-go" areas or under displacement orders, which has increased displacement. Between the 22nd of May and the 27th, an estimated 22,743 individuals were displaced. 7,328 of those individuals were displaced in the last 24 hours alone. This brings the estimated number of individuals displaced between 15 and 27 May to 90,916 in the three southern governorates and 104,204 in the two northern governorates, based on reported movements, including those following direct targeting of displacement sites.
