## OVERVIEW OF DISPLACEMENT MOVEMENTS

- Three displacement orders have been issued on July 8th, 11th and 15th. Since May 15th, over 30 displacement orders have been issued. As of July 9th, **2.1M people** currently live in Gaza and **87% of the territory** is currently either within militarized areas or under displacement orders (OCHA).
- An estimated **11,662** new displacements were reported during the week of July 8-15th which remains comparable to the figure from last week. More than half of known movements were intra-governorate, primarily occurring within Gaza Governorate. The remaining movements mainly occurred from the northern to the southern governorates. Additionally, 40% of all recorded movements originated either from or to Al Mawasi in Khan Younis and a significant wave of movements occurred from Jabalia to West Gaza City.
- This brings the number of displacements since the escalation of military activity on May 15th to 299,757; 123,087 in the southern 3 governorates, and 176,670 in the northern 2 governorates. Since the end of the ceasefire on March 18th, 737,355 displacements have been recorded.

## METHODOLOGY

- Data was collected from eyewitness accounts, social media posts and Site Management Cluster (SMC) partners on the ground.
- The numbers refer to displacements, and not individuals. People displace multiple times, therefore what is reported is flow figures rather than stock figures.
- Access constraints continue to pose significant challenges, impacting data quality. As a result, the majority of movements are recorded with either unknown origins or destinations.
