OVERVIEW OF DISPLACEMENT MOVEMENTS

- As of **July 29th**, 2.1M people currently live in Gaza and **89%** of the territory is currently either within militarized areas or under displacement orders (OCHA).
- An estimated 5,235 new displacements were reported during the week of July 22-29, with over 80% of the recorded movements originating from or occurring within Khan Younis.
- This brings the number of displacements since the escalation of military activity on May 15th to 330,230; 148,790 in the southern 3 governorates, and 181,440 in the northern 2 governorates.
- Since the end of the ceasefire on **March 18th, 767,828** displacements have been recorded.

METHODOLOGY

- Data was collected from eyewitness accounts, social media posts, and available datasets from Site Management Cluster (SMC) partners on the ground. The information was cross-referenced and analyzed to establish displacement patterns.
- The numbers refer to displacements, and not individuals. People displace multiple times, therefore what is reported is flow figures rather than stock figures.
- Access constraints continue to pose significant challenges, impacting data quality. As a result, the majority of movements are recorded with either unknown origins or destinations.
