## OVERVIEW OF DISPLACEMENT MOVEMENTS

- As of 10 September, an estimated 2.1 million people live in Gaza, with **86.5%** of the territory either within militarized areas or under displacement orders. (OCHA)
- During the reporting period, military operations have continued to intensify in Gaza city, the origin of **63%** of recorded displacement movements, prompting people to flee the city, going primarily Southwards to Deir Al Balah and Khan Younis.
- Between 07 – 10 September, **25,333** displacement movements were recorded. Since 14 August, an estimated **73,561** movements were observed crossing from North to South.

## METHODOLOGY

- Data was collected from eyewitness accounts, social media posts, and available datasets from Site Management Cluster (SMC) partners on the ground. The information was cross-referenced and analyzed to establish displacement patterns.
- The data collected through the flow monitoring points reflects only displacement movements recorded up to 2:00 PM on 10 September 2025 (Gaza Time). Data collected after this time will be reflected in the following report.
- The numbers refer to displacements, and not individuals. People displace multiple times, therefore what is reported is flow figures rather than stock figures.
- Access constraints continue to pose significant challenges, impacting data quality. As a result, the majority of movements are recorded with either unknown origins or destinations.
